1. **Introduction**

1.1 The purpose of this report is to advise Committee of a petition from residents in Kipps Avenue.

2. **Background**

2.1 The petition relates to a small area of ground which appears to have been "formed" some time ago from a large grassed embankment which surrounds the area.

2.2 It is not entirely clear what the area of ground in question is used for albeit it could be suitable for car-parking and there is a need for off-street car-parking provision in the area.

3. **Current Position**


3.1 The Area Office has arranged for the loose blocks to be removed from the surface to make the area safe, and costings have been obtained to carry out the works requested in the petition, albeit it should be noted that these works are not considered a priority at this time.

3.2 Before proceeding with any remedial works, consultation will take place with the residents concerned, as to the future use of the area of ground.

4. **Recommendations**

4.1 Committee is asked to note the action taken by the Area Office regarding the petition.
