1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 The purpose of this report is to inform Committee of action taken in response to a petition received from residents at Progress Drive, Dumbreck Avenue, Caldercruix

2 BACKGROUND

2.1 The Petition containing eighteen signatures related to a request from the residents to have door-canopies fitted above the front entrance doors to their houses in this re-roofing and re-rendering contract as has been fitted in the previous three phases of the re-rendering contracts in Caldercruix.

2.2 The fitting of door canopies was not included in the original specification due to an error in the tender documents

2.3 Negotiations have taken place with the Contractor to fit canopies at agreed rates. The additional costs can be accommodated within the Capital Programme Budget.

3 RECOMMENDATION

3.1 It is recommended that the Committee note the contents of the petition and approve the action taken to resolve this matter
