Secretary to inform North Lanarkshire Council of community concern in reference to the absence of road markings after re-surfacing work was carried out.

**The following points have been discussed with Councillor McKinlay and are in the progress of being dealt with:**

**Wall painting** Secretary to contact North Lanarkshire Council and Councillor McKinlay as to the removal of graffiti from the Health Centre walls.

The Secretary to request that the graffiti be removed at no expense to Doctor Bawa or community. Councillor McKinlay has this matter in hand.

**Dog Fouling Footpaths** This problem is again on the increase due in part to the seasons. North Lanarkshire Council mechanical footpath sweepers reported fouling on footpaths and secretary will request pressure washing of footpaths from North Lanarkshire Council.

**Litter Bins** are required within our community and secretary will request that North Lanarkshire Council put this matter in hand.

**1. Road Markings**

**2. Wall Cleaning**

Graffiti and the negative impact of this type of vandalism have rightly been targeted by NLC and our Councillor Jim McKinley has been made aware of the graffiti in question.

**3. Inchnuck Road**

The north part of this road was taken over by MDC from Glenboig Fireclay Co. This road has not been repaired for many years and again the disrepair has been highlighted to the community council. Councillor McKinley is aware of this disrepair and the Community Council has contacted NLC on this matter on more than one occasion. At this time this matter is with Mr F Haggerty NLC Roads.

**4. Storm Drains**

Storm drains in various roads are full of sand and grit and this matter has been reported to NLC. The cleaning cycle of once a year seems to require a rethink.

**5. Sub Committees**

Chair M Donahoe informed the committee of the progress of the committees that she is involved in and the Community Council asked that it's willingness to work with any body in the betterment of our community be conveyed to such committees and sub committees.

**6. Ramoan**
