Matters Arising from Minutes:

Point 9 – Discussed
 Information awaited from NLC via Cllr Clark.

Point 10 – Discussed
 As the full length of Inchnuck Road is approved and is part of NLC roads.

This road must be maintained as other roads and drains as well as firewater outlets must be maintained.

Litter should be picked and gullies cleaned. "Markon" lorries use this road as a parking lot, food/liquid containers and drink cans are strewn across this road. This litter is not cleared by NLC.

Point 14 – Discussed

Police report given by PC.Hart.

A/ The vandalism caused by youths jumping on a tenant's car, as part of a concerted terror campaign against this tenant was noted.

B/ A complaint was passed on to Police in regards to a 90-year old tenant being terrorised by this gang of youths. The tenant has not made contact with Police.

C/ Air guns on the Loch side were reported to Police and this was swiftly acted upon.

Point M2

Information on Lease arrangement with Markon and NLC to be requested by Sec R.Panton in regards to parking, loading and unloading of equipment which completely closes Inchnuck Road.

Point M3

Water from field to East of Coatbridge Road some 300yrs from Allan's Farm being allowed to spill onto Main Road and pavement.

Point M4

Grays yard gates have low "Spike" to stop yard gate when gates are closed. "Spike" is exposed and possibly dangerous. NLC may action this under by-law "clear pavement at all times".

Point M5

Barrets Site

Surface water is running over pavement and onto main road from two points of this site.

Point M6

Flashing "30" sign requested similar to sign fitted at Petersburn. Sec to phone NLC traffic. This point raised by G.Brown.
