BACKGROUND

Adult Guidance and Employment Counselling is now regarded as fundamental to a successful labour market policy by all the member states of the European Union. In the rapidly changing and flexible labour market which exists in Europe and at international level it is essential that job-seekers are matched accurately to job opportunities and that all adults have the chance to keep developing their careers throughout their lives.

AIMS

The conference is being sponsored by Renfrewshire Enterprise. It will bring experts in Adult Guidance and Employment Counselling from around Europe to share experience and discuss developments on some of the important questions facing senior practitioners and policy makers.

TARGET AUDIENCE

The conference will be of interest to all those working in the area of Adult Guidance and Employment Counselling. This includes people from the Careers Service, LEC's and TEC's, Further Education Colleges, Private Training Providers, Universities, Local Economic Development areas, the Employment Service and other agencies in the UK and Europe involved in Guidance and Counselling.

Participants will take away interesting and useful information on successful policy development and practice in Europe relating to the themes of the conference.

Speakers so far confirmed are Linda Ammon of the UK Department for Education and Employment, Dick Beekhuizen from the Ministry of Social Affairs in the Netherlands, George Kynoch MP, Scottish Office Minister for Industry and Local Government, Evelyn McCann, Head of Skills, Scottish Enterprise, Wendy O'Conghaile of the European Foundation for the Improvement of Living and Working Conditions, Dr Peter Plant, Associate Professor at the Royal Danish School of Educational Studies and Glenys Watt, Coordinator of the Eurocounsel Programme. In addition, there will be speakers from the European Commission and experts in Adult Guidance and Employment Counselling from Italy, Spain, France, Ireland, Germany, Eastern Europe and the UK.

The official language of the conference is English, which will be used for all presentations and printed material.
