LEISURE GRANTS FUND FOR AD-HOC APPLICATIONS - SPORT  
AND RECREATION

1. Under reference to paragraph 2 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 26 June 1997, there was submitted six reports dated 2 and 23 June 1997 by the Director of Leisure Services regarding applications for Sport and Recreation Ad-Hoc grants received from respectively (1) Blackburn Rovers Boys' Club;

(2) Clyde Valley Beavers Disabled Sports Club; (3) Aston Villa Boys' Club; (4) Glah Hahn Thai Boxing Gym; (5) Scottish Women's Football Association, and (6) Tryst Handball Club/Scottish Handball Association.

Decided: that the applications for Sport and Recreation Ad-Hoc grants be dealt with as follows, viz:-

Applicant: Blackburn Rovers Boys' Club

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of the hire of Strathclyde Park on 3 and 4 May 1997 for the Club's Annual Football Festival.

Grant Requested: \$1,070

Decision: That a grant of \$1,070 be awarded.

Applicant: Clyde Valley Beavers Disabled Sports Club

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of holding the 1997 Club Gala.

Grant Requested: \$175

Decision: That a grant of \$175 be awarded.

Applicant: Aston Villa Boys' Club

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of hosting the Club's Annual Tournament between 2 and 8 June 1997

Grant Requested: \$350

Decision: That a grant of \$350 be awarded.

Applicant: Glah Hahn Thai Boxing Gym

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of holding a kick-boxing event (Scotland -v- Ireland -v- England) on 24 May 1997.

Grant Requested: \$326

Decision: That the request be refused.

Applicant: Scottish Women's Football Association

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of holding the Association's Scottish Cup Final at Broadwood Stadium, Cumbernauld on 4 May 1997.

Grant Requested: \$360

Decision: That a grant of \$360 be awarded.

Applicant: Tryst Handball Club/Scottish Handball Association

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of hosting a Handball International on 17 September 1997 at the Tryst Sports Centre, Cumbernauld.

Grant Requested: \$187

Decision: That a grant of \$187 be awarded.

APPLICATIONS - CULTURAL PROJECT FUNDING

2. Under reference to paragraph 3 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 26 June 1997, there were submitted two reports dated 10 October 1997 by the Director of Leisure Services regarding applications for Cultural Project Funding received from respectively Music in Hospitals, and Cumbernauld Theatre Trust Limited. There were then submitted two reports (tabled) dated 10 and 14 October 1997 by the Director of

Services regarding applications for Cultural Project Funding received from respectively Strathaven Choral Society, and the National Jazz Institute.

The Director of Leisure Services, having advised that an application for Cultural Project Funding had been received from Shotts Community Music indicated that it had subsequently been withdrawn.

Decided: that the applications for Cultural Project Funding be dealt with as follows, viz:-

Applicant: Music in Hospitals - Music is the Key Project

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of funding a series of 10 concerts for the elderly within North Lanarkshire through Senior Citizens Centres within Leisure Services.

Grant Requested: \$900

Decision: That a grant of \$900 be awarded.

Applicant: Cumbernauld Theatre Trust Limited - Open Doors Project

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of funding a series of 6 open days designed to provide access opportunities to expose a wider public to Cumbernauld Theatre.

Grant Requested: \$3,000 to be offset against the grant of \$23,000 previously awarded on 25 November 1996 to Cumbernauld Theatre Trust Limited towards potential projects which may be carried out by the Theatre during the period 1996-98.

Decision: That a grant of \$3,000 be awarded and offset against the \$23,000 advance payment made in the financial year 1996/97.

Applicant: Strathaven Choral Society - Family Music Afternoons Project

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of funding a programme of 12 musical activities in Communities throughout Lanarkshire (six in each of North and South Lanarkshire).

Grant Requested: \$900

Decision: That a grant of \$900 be awarded.

Applicant: National Jazz Institute - Outreach Programme

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards the cost of funding a series of Outreach Workshops designed to take jazz education and experience to the Community at large.

Grant Requested: \$1,500

Decision: That a grant of \$1,500 be awarded.
