1. **Organisation** : Craigneuk and Petersburn Women Writers' Group
2. **Project Title** : Sustrans Public Art Project
3. **Project Summary** : Public Art Work - comprising photographs and poems on the railway bridge at Cairnhill on the Glasgow to Edinburgh cycle route currently being developed by SUSTRANS.

SUSTRANS is creating a cross Scotland cycle route linking Glasgow with Edinburgh. They aim to enhance the path by providing a series of art works along the route which are closely identified and involved with the communities through which the route passes. This proposal is part of this plan.

Professional artist Anne Elliot will produce photographic images on which will be superimposed a series of short texts by the Craigneuk and Petersburn Women Writers' Group. These will comprise two panels. Each approximately 4m high and 8m wide.

4. **Timescale** : 1998
5. **Project Cost** : £10,967.72
6. **Amount Requested** : £4,500

(Other funding partners to the project have included Scottish Arts Council, Scottish Office and Monklands District Council.)

7. **Eligibility** : The project meets the eligibility criteria.
8. **Recommendation** : That funding of £4,500 be made to Craigneuk and Petersburn Women Writers' Group to allow the above project to be carried out.
