**LEISURE GRANTS FUND FOR AD-HOC APPLICATIONS - CULTURAL SERVICES - SCOTTISH BRASS BAND CHAMPIONSHIPS 1999**

1. There was submitted a report dated 22 April 1998 by the Director of Leisure Services regarding an application for a Cultural Services Ad-Hoc grant received from the Scottish Amateur Brass Band Association towards the administrative costs associated with the Association holding their Scottish Championships in Motherwell Concert Hall on 27 and 28 February 1999.

There was submitted a report dated 17 April 1998 by the Director of Leisure Services regarding an application for a Sport and Recreation Ad-Hoc grant received from Cumbernauld Goodwill Classique Gymnastics Competition and the Director of Leisure Services thereafter orally (1) reminded Members that, at their meeting on 26 June 1997, the Sub-Committee had remitted to the Policy and Resources Committee, a request from the National Rowing Championships of Great Britain for a grant of £5,000 towards the costs of holding The National Rowing Championships in Strathclyde Park in July 1998; (2) advised that, at their meeting on 2 September 1997, the Policy and Resources Committee had authorised a grant of £5,000 to be made to the National Rowing Championships of Great Britain, the costs to be met from this year's budget, and (3) indicated that a cheque, to the value of £5,000, was to be subsequently handed to the Organisation at a Ceremony to be held on a date to be arranged.
