 1. **Introduction**

This report details various Core and Revenue Grant payments that have been made in relation to the 1997/98 and 1998/99 budgets.

 2. **1998/99 Budget**
**Cumbernauld Theatre**

The grant to Cumbernauld Theatre for 1998/99 is £116,020 inclusive of £8,120 building costs. This historically has been paid on a quarterly basis.

The matter of an annual application remains outstanding alongside the completion of an appropriate contract. It is intended that these are finalised for the next financial year.

 3. **1997/98 Budget**
**National Performing Arts Organisations**

The 1998/99 payment for the National Performing Arts Organisation was brought forward to the 1997/98 budget. Payments were made as follows:
