LEISURE GRANTS - BUDGET PAYMENTS MADE FROM 1 APRIL 1997 TO 31 MAY 1998

1. There was submitted a report (docketed) dated 24 August 1998 by the Director of Leisure Services containing details of payments made to various organisations from the Leisure Services Grants Budget during the period from 1 April 1997 to 31 May 1998.

CULTURAL GRANTS FUND FOR CORE AND PROJECT APPLICATIONS - CULTURAL PROJECT FUNDING

4. There were submitted reports dated 24 August 1998 by the Director of Leisure Services regarding applications for Cultural Project Funding received from (1) Drama Enterprise, Motherwell; (2) Goal Education Limited, Traquair; (3) Scottish Chamber Orchestra, and (4) Trestle Theatre Company, Hertfordshire. Project Title: Kick Start

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards cost of project, designed specifically to encourage both boys and girls to participate in dance and develop an interest in the sport of football.

Grant requested: £836

Decision: that a grant of £836 be awarded.

Applicant: Scottish Chamber Orchestra

Project Title: SINGUENDO II

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards cost of holding six workshops over a six week period with a range of North Lanarkshire choral groups and singers with a final performance by the orchestra and participants being held in the New Town Hall, Cumbernauld on 18 October 1998.

Grant requested: £2,618

Decision: that a grant of £2,618 be awarded.

Applicant: Trestle Theatre Company, Hertfordshire

Project Title: Trestle Professional Theatre Workshops

Purpose of Application: Assistance towards cost of holding thirteen workshops at various Community Centres throughout the North Lanarkshire area with a view to providing a professional theatre experience to children and young people aged 5-18 years old.

Grant requested: £1,433

Decision: that a grant of £1,433 be awarded.
