Change Plan Contribution

- Voluntary sector is one of four key partners to sign off local Change Plan
- Devolved budget of 20% for Community Capacity Building and Carer Support

- Glenboig Neighbourhood House leads on local voluntary sector coordination via NL Locality Partnership Development Programme and hosts local consortium
