

EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTE OF MEETING OF THE EDUCATION (RESOURCES) SUB-COMMITTEE OF 15 JANUARY 1998

BUILDINGS TO BE DECLARED SURPLUS TO EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

(1) FORMER JANITOR'S HOUSE AT GLENCRYAN SCHOOL, CUMBERNAULD

- (2) There was submitted a report dated 5 January 1998 by the Director of Education (1) advising that the former janitor's house at Glencryan School, Cumbernauld had remained unoccupied for several years and as a result had now become derelict and that the Chief Estates Officer considered it did not have any economic value, and (2) recommending that the house at Glencryan School, Cumbernauld be declared surplus to educational requirements and demolished.

Thereon Councillor E. Burns, seconded by Councillor Gilchrist, moved

- (1) that the former janitor's house at Glencryan School, Cumbernauld be declared surplus to educational requirements and demolished, and
- (2) that this report be referred to the Planning and Development Committee for consideration.

Councillor G. Murray, seconded by Councillor Russell, moved as an amendment that the matter be continued pending the submission of a full report to a future meeting detailing the circumstances surrounding the maintenance of the former janitor's house at Glencryan School, Cumbernauld after it was vacated.

On a vote being taken 2 Members voted for the amendment and 8 Members voted for the motion, which was accordingly declared to be carried.

Decided:

- (1) that the former janitor's house at Glencryan School, Cumbernauld be declared surplus to educational requirements and demolished, and
- (2) that the report be referred to the Planning and Development Committee for consideration.
