

EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTE OF MEETING OF THE EDUCATION (RESOURCES) SUB-COMMITTEE OF 15 JANUARY 1998

(2) BENHAR PRIMARY, EASTFIELD AND HARTHILL PRIMARY, HARTHILL

- (3) There was submitted a report dated 5 January 1998 by the Director of Education (1) intimating that, as part of the Capital Works Programme approved by the Education Committee, work had been undertaken to build a single school at Benhar/Harthill to replace the existing Benhar and Harthill Primary Schools, and (2) recommending that the buildings and sites at the existing Benhar and Harthill Primary Schools be declared surplus to educational requirements.

Decided:

- (1) that the buildings and sites at the existing Benhar Primary and Harthill Primary Schools be declared surplus to educational requirements on the anticipated completion of the replacement school at Benhar/Harthill in July 1999, and
- (2) that the report be remitted to the Planning and Development Committee for consideration.

Purpose and Content of Report

To recommend that the buildings and sites at Benhar Primary, Eastfield and Harthill Primary, Harthill be declared surplus to educational requirements.

Background

As part of the capital works programme approved by committee the education department is building a single school to replace the two existing primary schools. The buildings and sites will be surplus to education department requirements when the new school is completed. The anticipated completion date is July 1999.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the education resources sub-committee approve that:

- (i) Benhar Primary, Eastfield and Harthill Primary, Harthill be declared surplus to educational requirements on completion of the replacement school.
- (ii) responsibility for the disposal of the buildings and sites be transferred to the planning and development committee.
- (iii) this report be referred to the planning and development committee.
