

EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF LEISURE SERVICES COMMITTEE OF
28 JANUARY 1998

WRANGHOLM HALL BOWLING CLUB - PROPOSED EXTENSION

32. There was submitted a report dated 8 January 1998 by the Director of Leisure Services (1) advising of a request which had been received from Wrangholm Hall Bowling Club that it be allowed to supplement its existing Clubhouse facilities; (2) indicating that, in terms of its lease, the Club required the Council's permission prior to making an application to the Scottish Sports Council Lottery Fund for funding towards these works, and (3) containing his observations thereon.

Decided:

- (1) that the proposed improvements to the existing facilities at Wrangholm Hall Bowling Club be approved, subject to the necessary Planning consent being obtained, and
- (2) that the matter be otherwise referred to the Planning and Development (Buildings and Property) Sub-Committee for its interest regarding the lease agreement.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek the approval of the Leisure Services Committee to allow Wrangholm Hall Bowling Club to supplement the existing clubhouse facilities.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Wrangholm Bowling Club are subject to a 21 year lease agreement with North Lanarkshire Council. In an effort to extend their existing storage areas and construct additional changing facilities, the club propose to apply for financial assistance from the Scottish Sports Council Lottery Fund.
- 2.2 However, under the terms of the lease, the club require the written permission of the Department of Leisure Services, prior to making the funding application. Similarly, the Department of Planning and Development have also been informed of their intentions.

3. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 3.1 That Committee approve the proposed improvements to the existing facilities, subject to the appropriate planning permission being obtained.
- 3.2 That the Planning and Development Committee be advised accordingly.
