THE NORTH LANARKSHIRE COUNCIL, CUMBERNAULD VILLAGE,
CUMBERNAULD - 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT, INSTALLATION OF ROAD
HUMPS AND SPEED TABLES AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT
MEASURES - CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS

1. There was submitted a report dated 8 January 1997 by the Director of Administration seeking approval to introduce the North Lanarkshire Council (Cumbernauld Village, Cumbernauld) (Traffic Management) Order and with regard to the North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Cumbernauld Village) (Temporary 20 mph Speed Limits) Order, which sought to enhance road safety and improve amenity in the area, to authorise the Director of Administration to approach the Secretary of State for Scotland to approve the latter Order.

Decided:

- (1) that the Sub-Committee agree to the introduction of the North Lanarkshire Council (Cumbernauld Village, Cumbernauld) (Traffic Management) Order as detailed in the report, and
- (2) that the Sub-Committee authorise the Director of Administration to approach the Secretary of State for Scotland for authorisation to introduce the North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Cumbernauld Village) (Temporary 20 mph Speed Limits) Order.

Cairntoul Court, Balloch, Cumbernauld) (Temporary 20 mph
Speed Limit) Order, which would effectively create a 20 mph zone
over the entire lengths of Grampian Way, Cairngorm Gardens and
Cairntoul Court in order to enhance road safety and improve
amenity in the area.

Decided:that the Director of Administration be authorised to
approach the Secretary of State for Scotland for
consent to introduce the North Lanarkshire Council
(Grampian Way, Cairngorm Gardens and Cairntoul
Court, Balloch, Cumbernauld) (Temporary 20 mph
Speed Limit) Order.

THE NORTH LANARKSHIRE COUNCIL (B7066, SALSBURGH) (40
MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER -CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS

3. There was submitted a report dated 13 January 1997 by the
Director of Administration seeking approval to introduce the

Lanarkshire Council (B7066, Salsburgh) (40 mph Speed Limit)
Order, effectively extending the existing 40 mph restrictions
currently in force on the B7066 from the east end of Salsburgh,
eastwards for a distance of approximately 680 metres, to a point
175 metres east of the extended east kerbline of Duntilland Road
in order to improve road safety in the area.
