(1) **BACKGROUND**

Following a decision of the Planning and Development Committee of Monklands District Council dated 13 March 1996, which decision was ratified by that Council at its meeting on 28 March 1996, the draft of the "North Lanarkshire Council (Part of Footpath to South of 31 Graham Street, Airdrie) Stopping Up Order 1996" was made on behalf of North Lanarkshire Council, and advertised in the Airdrie and Coatbridge Advertiser, and the Edinburgh Gazette on 26 July 1996. One letter of objection was received to the draft Order which objection was subsequently withdrawn, and therefore the Order now requires to be confirmed by the Council. The Order relates to the area shown outlined on the attached plan and is necessary to implement a planning permission (PA 95558) previously granted by Monklands District Council for formation of a pedestrian ramp/access.

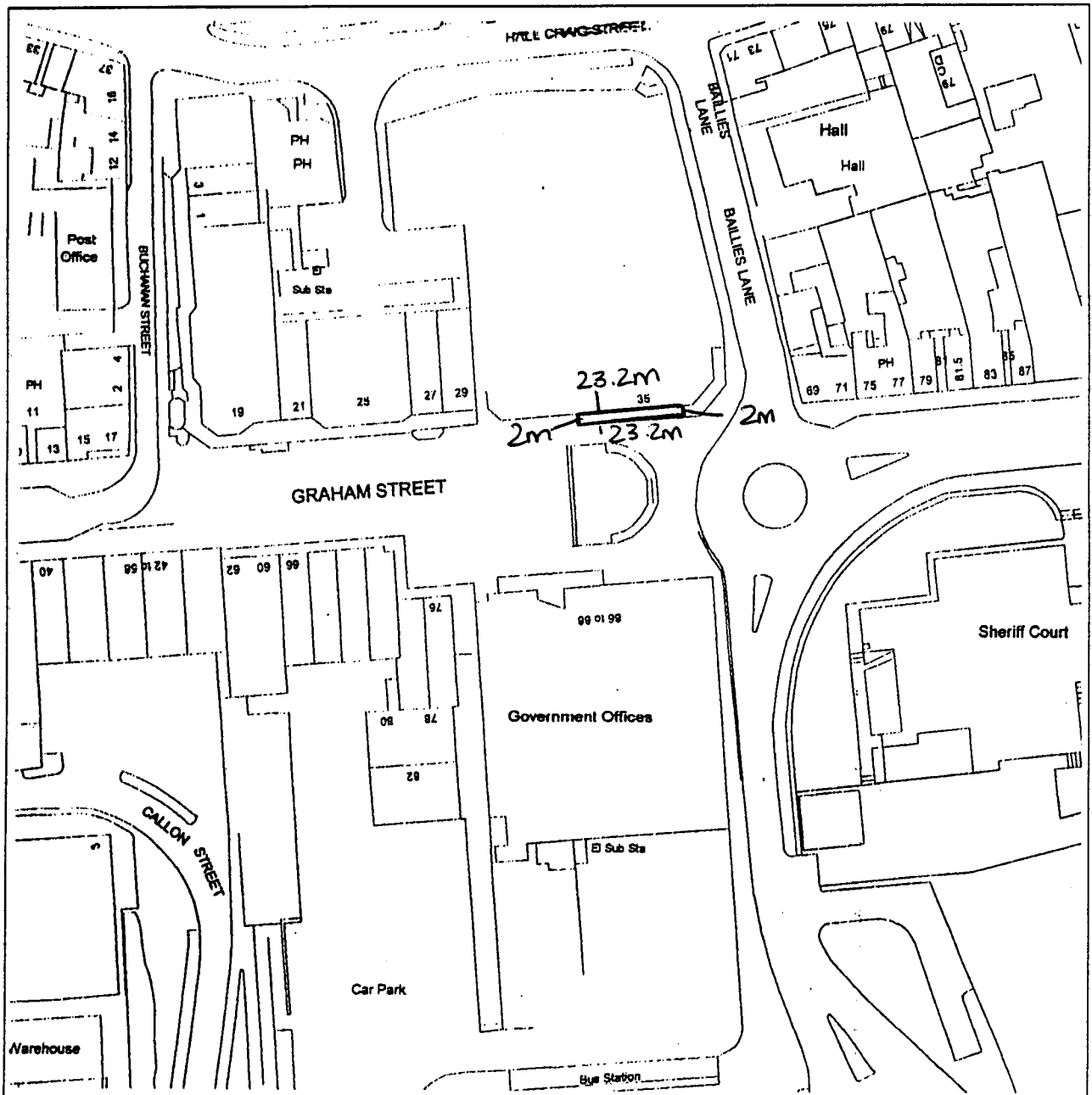
(2) **RECOMMENDATION**
