1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek authority to confirm the Stopping Up of a footpath between Bank Road and Sprig Way, Harthill.

2. Background

- 2.1 Planning permission was granted on 18 October 2004 for the erection of a fence to enclose a dwelling at 5 Sprig Way, Harthill. This development has severed a footpath between Bank Road and Sprig Way, which requires to be stopped up.
- 2.2 The Stopping Up Order was advertised under Section 207 of the Act and statutory undertakers notified. No objections to the order were received.

- 4.1 There are no corporate implications.

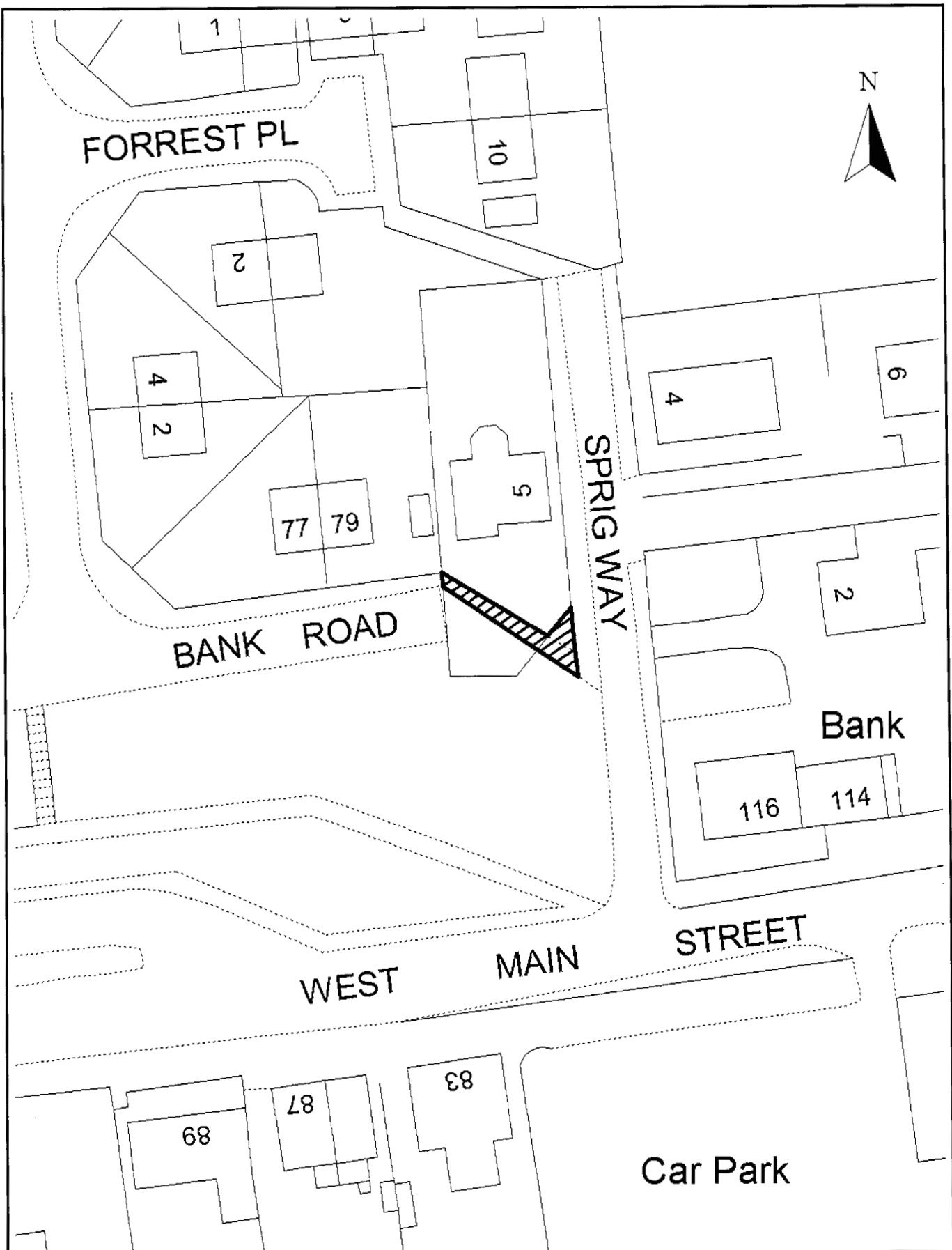
5. Recommendations
