### 1. Purpose of Report

The Committee are asked to approve the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on Calder Road, Clydesdale Road and Hope Street, Mossend. The Order will only be effective when the lights are activated on the speed limit signs.

### 2. Report

2.1. Following the successful Government trial of 20 mph mandatory speed limits outside schools, which was carried out in 2000, the Council is now committed to introducing mandatory 20 mph speed limits to approve safety around schools and safer routes to schools for walking and cycling.

2.2. A consultation was undertaken with the view to implementation of a mandatory 20 mph speed limit on:-

2.2.1. Calder Road, Mossend from a point 74 metres north of the extended north kerbline of Hope Street, southwards to a point 42 metres south of the extended south kerbline of Clyde Drive, a distance of 472 metres or thereby.

2.2.2. Clydesdale Road, Mossend from Calder Road eastwards to a point 47 metres east of the extended east kerbline of Christie Street, a distance of 224 metres or thereby.

2.2.3. Hope Street, Mossend, from Calder Road westwards and northwards to its termination, a distance of 193 metres or thereby.

2.3. The Council has advertised its proposal to introduce the Order by public advertisement, to which no objections were received. In addition, the Chief Constable, the local Councillor and various public and other bodies were consulted and offered no objections to the proposal.

### 3. Recommendation

That the Committee approve the introduction of the North Lanarkshire Council (Mossend and Holy Family Primary Schools, Calder Road, Clydesdale Road and Hope Street, Mossend) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2005 as detailed in 2.2 of the report.
