1. Purpose of Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to recommend acceptance of the tender from T I Coatings Ltd for the contract, 'Clyde Bridge Painting'.

2. Background

- 2.1 The works comprise painting to the main structural steelwork of the bridge, removal of redundant service ducts and minor concrete repairs to the deck soffit.
- 2.2 The works are programmed to be carried out between August 2005 and January 2006. Pedestrian diversions will be in operation during the course of the contract. Short term off-peak lane closures will be required throughout the contract to service the works.
- 2.3 Funding is contained within the Planning and Environment Capital Allocation 2005/06 under the heading of Bridge Investment Programme. The bridge is jointly owned with South Lanarkshire Council who will contribute 50% of the funding.
- 2.4 Tender documents were issued to six contractors, all of whom returned tenders as follows:

2.6 The works are to be executed on land wholly owned by the Council.

2.7 Arrangements are in place to promote the appropriate Temporary Traffic Order for pedestrian diversions.

2.8 The Pre-Tender Health and Safety Plan has been prepared by the Planning Supervisor and issued to all tenderers. The Contractor for this project will prepare the Construction Phase Health and Safety Plan prior to work commencing on site.

3. **Recommendations**

3.1 The tender submitted by T I Coatings Ltd is recommended for acceptance.
