1. Purpose of Report

1.1 The purpose of this report is to seek authority to confirm the Stopping Up of a footpath linking Mary Glen and Coldstream Crescent, Cambusnethan, Wishaw.

2. Background

2.1 Delegated Approval was granted on the 13th November 2003 for the promotion of a Stopping Up Order in respect of the footpath that crosses Mossneuk Plantation from Mary Glen and Coldstream Crescent, Cambusnethan. The proposal includes the erection of fencing at one end of the footpath, which is to be erected by the Council under the Council's permitted development rights.

3. Sustainability Implications

3.1 There are no sustainability implications.

4. Proposals / Considerations


4.1 It is proposed to block up the footpath at the entrance to the footpath from Mary Glen, Cambusnethan with a 2-metre high timber fence. It is not proposed to erect a fence at the Coldstream Crescent entrance to the footpath so as to allow maintenance of the recreation ground adjacent to Coldstream Crescent, Cambusnethan. The remaining section of the footpath is to be removed. One letter of objection was received in connection with this Stopping Up Order but has since been withdrawn. It is proposed that the works be carried out at the end of the financial year provided that there is sufficient money within the budget. In the event that it cannot be completed by the end of the financial year, the works will be programmed into next year's programme.

5. Corporate Considerations

5.1 There are no corporate implications.

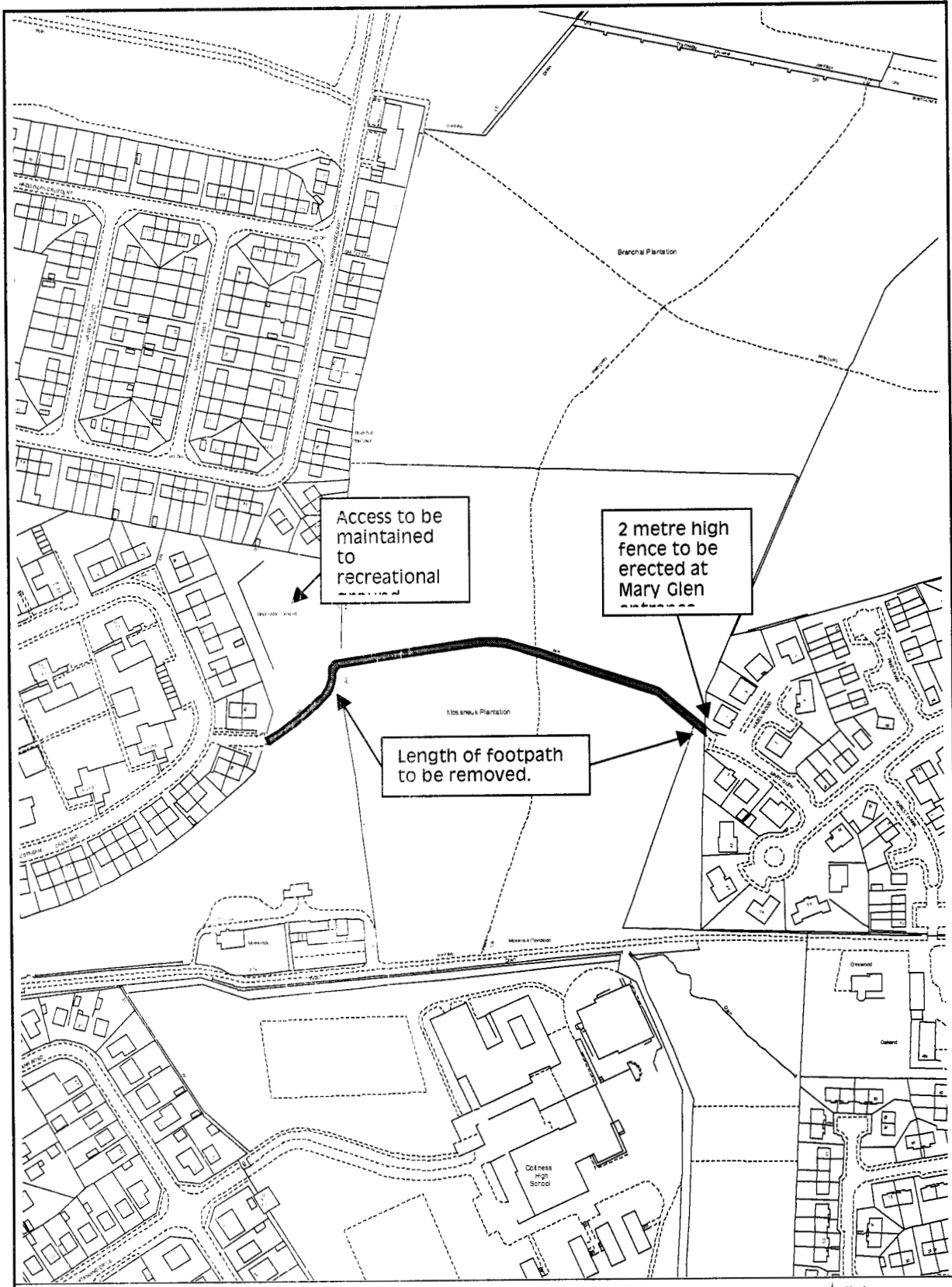
6. Recommendations
