## 1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to recommend acceptance of a negotiated tender with Colas Ltd for the “Repave Resurfacing Process (Northern Area) 2005/06” contract.

## 2. Background

- 2.1 On 17 August 2005 committee gave approval, inter alia, for the Director of Planning and Environment to negotiate a tender with Colas Ltd. for the above contract. This negotiation has taken place and Colas Ltd. have submitted a tender for the works amounting to £88,775.50. Notwithstanding the amount tendered, the Contractor was advised after negotiation, that they should expect to be given between £90,000 and £150,000 worth of work.

- 2.2 The project costs arising comprise

Tender Costs	£150,000
Contingencies	<u>£15,000</u>
Total	<u>£165,000</u>

- 2.3 The tender of £88,775.50, submitted by Colas Ltd., represents good value when benchmarked against costs for conventional resurfacing. Funding for this project is contained in the Planning and Environmental Budget for 2005/06 under the heading of Road & Footway Refurbishment Programme.
- 2.4 The Pre – Tender Health and Safety Plan has been prepared and will be developed by the Contractor prior to commencement of the works. Statutory consents are not required and project management arrangements will be introduced to achieve cost effective project completion.

**3. Recommendation**

**3.1** It is recommended that Committee authorise acceptance of the Tender submitted by Colas Ltd.
