1. Purpose of Report

The Committee are asked to approve the introduction of a Traffic Regulation Order to introduce a one way operation on Watt Crescent, Bellshill, from its northern junction with Hattonrigg Road, southwards then eastwards to its southern junction with Hattonrigg Road, to permit vehicles to travel in a southward then eastward direction only.

2. Report

- 2.1. Watt Crescent, Bellshill is located in the southern operational area of North Lanarkshire Council with both junctions on Hattonrigg Road. Onstreet parking on Watt Crescent causes difficulties for through movement of vehicles.
- 2.2. In order to alleviate these difficulties and in the interest of road safety, it is proposed to introduce a One Way Order allowing vehicles access only to Watt Crescent from the northern junction on Hattonrigg Road.
- 2.3. The Council have advertised its proposals to introduce the Order by way of public advertisement, to which no objections were received. In addition, the Chief Constable, the local Councillor and various public and other bodies have been consulted and have offered no objections to the proposal.

3. Recommendation

That the Committee approve the introduction of the North Lanarkshire Council (Watt Crescent, Bellshill) (One Way) Order 2005 as detailed in 2.2 of the report.
