1. Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to obtain approval for the acceptance of a tender from Amey Roads North Lanarkshire for "Capital Resurfacing 2 – Central Area 2005/06" contract.

2. Resources

Briefly, the works consist of resurfacing various carriageways within the Central Area of North Lanarkshire Council. Funding for this work is contained in the Planning and Environment Capital Budget for 2005/2006 under the heading Road/Footway Resurfacing Programme. Tenderers were advised that, notwithstanding the amount tendered, the Contractor appointed should expect to be given between £300,000 and £400,000 worth of work.

3. Consideration

Tender documents were issued to 6 Contractors 5 of whom submitted tenders as follows:

The project costs, based on budget values, are highlighted below:-

The tender of £290,114.26 submitted by Amey Roads North Lanarkshire has been consistently and competitively priced and is worthy of consideration for acceptance.

The pre-tender Construction Phase Health and Safety Plan has been issued and will be developed by the successful contractor prior to commencing the works.

5. Recommendations

It is recommended that Committee:

2. Authorises acceptance of the tender submitted by Amey Roads North Lanarkshire.
