1. The purpose of this report is to inform committee of proposals to fund Playschemes in 1996/97.
2. At its meeting of 28 May 1996, the Policy and Resources Community Development Sub Committee considered the establishment of an Interim Community Grants Scheme and, in doing so agreed to top-slice the sum of £31,000 to fund Playschemes operating during Summer, October and Easter School holidays in 1996/97.
3. The Council is now in receipt of 47 applications which are requesting financial assistance as detailed in appendix 1 of the report.

In consideration of these requests, attention is drawn to the wide variances in the level of funding sought in relation to the level of Playscheme provision proposed.

4. The Committee may wish to consider adopting a formulae which would ensure that grant awards reflect the level of service provided

The following Formula for funding Playschemes in 1996/97 is therefore proposed

Grant award is based on a point allocation system where points are allocated per session. One session being not more than 4 hours, with a maximum of 2 sessions per day being funded.

A further allocation of points would be applied to reflect certain circumstances.

Playschemes catering for less than 50 children - 1 point per session

Playschemes catering for 50 children or more - 2 points per session

Playschemes catering for children under 8 years - 20 points

Playschemes integrating children with special needs - 30 points

Total points for all playschemes is then divided into budget allocation to give a pence per point figure. The Grant award therefore equals total points and pence per points.

6. It is anticipated that the Council may receive late applications and it is suggested that £500 top-sliced to accommodate this situation. It is suggested that Committee only approve funding for Summer period thereby creating scope to further consider applications later in the year.

It is recommended that Committee

1. Approve Formula to Fund Playschemes operating during 1996/97.
2. Approve grant allocation to Playschemes operating during Summer 1996 as detailed in Appendix 1.
3. Agree to top-slice £500 to fund applications received later in the year.
4. Otherwise note the report.
