1. The purpose of this report is to inform Committee of proposals to fund Playschemes operating in October 1996/97.
2. At its meeting of 28 May 1996, the Policy and Resources Community Development Sub-Committee considered the establishment of an Interim Community Grants Scheme and, in doing so agreed to top-slice the sum of £31,000 to fund Playschemes operating during Summer, October and Easter school holidays in 1996/97.
3. At its meeting of 20 June 1996, the Policy and Resources Community Development Sub-Committee agreed in its consideration of requests for financial assistance to adopt a formula which would ensure that grant awards to Playschemes reflected the level of service provided.
- 3.1 Committee is reminded of the details of the formula

*Grant award is based on a point allocation system where points are allocated per session. One session being not more than 4 hours, with a maximum of 2 sessions per day being funded.*

*A further allocation of points would be applied to reflect certain circumstances*

*Playschemes catering for less than 50 children - 1 point per session*

*Playschemes catering for 50 children or more - 2 points per session*

*Playschemes catering for children under 8 years - 20 points*

*Playschemes integrating children with special needs - 30 points*

*Total points for all playschemes is then divided into budget allocation to give a pence per point figure. The grant award therefore equals total points and pence per points.*

4. The council is in receipt of 33 applications for financial assistance from Playschemes wishing to operate in October, as detailed in Appendix I of this report. Proposed grant allocation totals £4,132.50, leaving £4,032.93 for anticipated demand for funding during Easter 1997.

5. Recommendation

It is recommended that Committee

- (a) Approve grant allocations to Playschemes operating during October 1996 as detailed in Appendix I.
- (b) Otherwise note the contents of the report.
