AREA COMMITTEES - SUBMISSION OF COMMUNITY COUNCIL MINUTES

1. With reference to paragraph 11 of the Minute of the meeting of the Policy and Resources (Community Development) Sub-Committee held on 4 March 1998 when that Sub-Committee had agreed, inter alia, that Minutes of meetings of Community Councils be submitted to appropriate Area Committees and that the Minutes of meetings of Area Committees be forwarded to appropriate Community Councils, there was submitted a report dated 26 February 1998 by the Director of Administration advising of the position.

AREA PROFILES - THE WAY FORWARD
