**COMMUNITY COUNCIL MINUTES**

With reference to paragraph 11 of the Minute of the meeting of the Policy and Resources (Community Development) Sub-Committee held on 4 March 1998 when that Sub-Committee had agreed (1) that the Minutes of the meetings of Community Councils be submitted to appropriate Area Committees, and (2) that the Minutes of the meetings of the Area Committees be forwarded to appropriate Community Councils, there was submitted a report dated 7 May 1998 by the Director of Administration enclosing the Minutes of the meetings of Kilsyth Community Council held on 18 March 1998 and Banton and Kelvinhead Community Council held on 25 March 1998.
