12. VOLUNTEERS WEEK 1998 - VOLUNTEER AWARDS

13. There was submitted a report dated 19 May 1998 by the Chief Executive (1) advising that Volunteers Week was being held during 1 to 7 June 1998 and was an annual UK wide event to recognise, reward and recruit volunteers; (2) intimating (a) that in 1997, the Council had hosted an event during Volunteers Week at which the work of approximately 100 volunteers had been recognised through the award of certificates, and (b) that North Lanarkshire Volunteering Development Agency had requested the Council to support a similar event this year as the Council's major contribution to Volunteers Week; (3) outlining arrangements of an award event which had taken place on Monday 1 June 1998 in the Colville Park Social Club, Motherwell, and (5) seeking a financial contribution of £500 towards the costs of the event, with the remainder being met by the North Lanarkshire Volunteering Development Agency.

Decided:

- (1) that the action taken by the Chief Executive's department in regard to the Volunteers Award event, be homologated;
- (2) that a contribution of £500 be awarded to North Lanarkshire Volunteering Development Agency towards the costs of the 1998 Volunteers Awards event, to be met from the Chief Executive's Payments to Agencies and Other Bodies Budget, and
- (3) that the contents of the report be otherwise noted.

CUMBERNAULD AND KILSYTH UNEMPLOYED WORKERS' CENTRE: FUNDING REQUEST TO CONTINUE FURNITURE RECYCLING PROJECT

14. With reference to paragraph 16 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 26 November 1997 when it had been agreed, *inter alia*, that Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Unemployed Workers Centre provide a detailed report on the outcome of a pilot furniture restoration and recycling project at the end of the funding period, there was submitted a report (docketed) dated 26 May 1998 by the Chief Executive (1) providing details on the operation and outcome of the project, and (2) advising that a request for further funding of £23,750 had been received from the Unemployed Workers' Centre for continuation of the furniture recycling project during the remainder of this financial year of which included £12,000 for storage, a contribution of £10,000 towards salary costs, £1,250 administration costs and £500 for cleaning, refurbishing and testing.

Decided:

- (1) that the Sub-Committee note (a) that the post of Education Worker was presently supported by the Council through grant aid, and (b) that the premises presently occupied by the Unemployed Workers Centre would be affected by plans for redevelopment of Cumbernauld Town Centre;
- (2) that an award of £1,750 be approved in principle to Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Unemployed Workers' Centre from the Chief Executive's Payments to Agencies and Other Bodies budget to assist with cleaning and administration costs associated with the furniture recycling project;
- (3) that the grant be released in two instalments, with the second instalment being released subject to the continued availability of premises;
- (4) that consideration of the application for funding for storage premises be deferred pending a future report on the necessity of such premises, potential locations and the costs involved;
- (5) that the application for contributory staffing costs be refused;
- (6) that Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Unemployed Workers' Centre be advised that responsibility for co-ordinating the furniture recycling project should be included as part of the remit of the existing Education Worker, and
- (7) that the contents of the report be otherwise noted.

AREA PROFILES - REVISED TIMESCALE

15. With reference to paragraph 14 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 26 November 1997 when, *inter alia*, a timescale of June 1998 had been agreed for production of area profiles, there was submitted a report (docketed) dated 20 May 1998 by the Chief Executive outlining for consideration (1) a revised timescale for the production of area profiles, and (2) an interim guidance note to facilitate progress on the development of area profiles by Area Committees.

Decided:

- (1) that a revised timescale for the production of area profiles by 30 November 1998 be approved;
- (2) that the interim guidance note for the development of area profiles by Area Committees be approved in the terms of the Chief Executive's report, and

GREENSPACE ACTION PROJECT - PETITION

16. With reference to paragraph 1 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 30 March 1998 when, *inter alia*, it had been agreed that the Greenspace Action project be funded until 30 April 1998, there was submitted a report dated 27 May 1998 by the Chief Executive (1) advising that a petition had been received from users of the Greenspace Action project against withdrawal of the funding, and (2) reminding members of (a) the Greenspace Action project; (b) the evaluation process established to consider applications for Urban Programme funding for projects terminating funding during 1997/98, and (c) the recommendations of the evaluation panel with regard to the Greenspace Action project.

Decided: that the petition and report be noted.

PROGRAMME FOR PARTNERSHIP

(1) MOTHERWELL NORTH PRIORITY PARTNERSHIP AREA (PPA) - PARTNERSHIP SUPPORT

17. With reference to paragraph 15 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 22 April 1998 when, *inter alia*, it was noted that additional resources had been made available by the Scottish Office to assist PPAs to establish dedicated support teams, there was submitted a report (docketed) dated 27 May 1998 by the Chief Executive advising on the progress in relation to the development of a support team for Motherwell North PPA, in particular (1) intimating that the Scottish Office had advised that Motherwell North PPA (a) would not be required to have formalised their support team arrangements by the submission date of 31 May 1998, and (b) were required to intimate intent to access funding in 1998/99; (2) indicating that partner contributions amounting to 30% of the cost had been secured, and (3) informing that a report on the outcome of discussions with regard to the future structure of the partnership and staffing required to support the structure would be brought forward for consideration at a future meeting of this Sub-Committee.

Decided:

- (1) that the Chief Executive be authorised to advise the Scottish Office of the intent to access available funding in 1998/99 for the development of a support team for the Motherwell North Priority Partnership area;
- (2) that a report detailing the structure of the partnership and staffing requirements, be brought forward for consideration to the next meeting of this Sub-Committee, and
- (3) that the contents of the report be otherwise noted.

(2) MOTHERWELL NORTH PRIORITY PARTNERSHIP AREA AND REGENERATION PROGRAMME - UPDATE

18. With reference to paragraph 15 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 22 April 1998 and paragraph 17 of the Minute of the meeting of this Sub-Committee held on 26 November 1997, there was submitted a report (docketed) dated 26 May 1998 by the Chief Executive advising on the progress in relation to the operation of Motherwell North Priority Partnership Area and the Regeneration Programme, in particular; (1) indicating that formal offers of grant had been received from the Scottish Office detailing the budget available to Motherwell North Priority Partnership Area and the North Lanarkshire Regeneration Programme in 1998/99, and, giving indicative budgets for 1999/00 and 2000/01; (2) intimating that both offers of grant had been accepted by the Director of Finance on behalf of the Council; (3) informing that in relation to the budget for the Regeneration Programme, the offer of grant confirmed revisions to the 1998/99 budget; (4) advising on issues which had arisen concerning Park Street Resource Centre, Whinhall Safe Play Action Project and

Airdrie North Community Project Limited (5) detailing, in Appendix 2 to the report, a revised funding profile incorporating proposed adjustments, and (6) intimating that the Scottish Office required the annual report in respect of Motherwell North Priority Partnership Area and Regeneration Programme to be submitted by 30 June 1998 and that a report on this matter would be presented to the next meeting of the Policy and Resources Committee for consideration.

Decided:

- (1) that the action taken by the Director of Finance to accept the offers of grant in respect of the budgets for Motherwell North Priority Partnership area and North Lanarkshire Regeneration Programme be homologated;
- (2) that approval be given to the amalgamation of Park Street Resource Centre and Whinhall Safe Play Action Projects into a new project entitled Safe Play and Resource Centre (SPARC);
- (3) that it be noted that the Management Committee of Airdrie North Community Project Limited would be unable to take up the Regeneration Programme funding already awarded;
- (4) that the revised funding profile, detailed in Appendix 2 to the report, be approved, and
- (5) that the contents of the report be otherwise noted.
