**REMIT FROM POLICY AND RESOURCES COMMITTEE OF 8 DECEMBER 1998 - NORTH LANARKSHIRE COMMUNITY SAFETY STRATEGY**

5. **MUIRHEAD PUBLIC PARK**

6. There was submitted a report dated 1 February 1999 by the Liaison Director (1) referring to a public meeting in Muirhead on 20 November 1998, held to discuss matters relating to the use of Moor Park; (2) detailing action which would be taken in relation to the maintenance of Bowling Green Road, the deposit of litter after football fixtures, misuse of the park by football teams, and conditions of let for football pitches, and (3) advising that the OAP Hut in Muirhead had been vandalised and set on fire.

- (2) that the Director of Administration be requested to bring forward a report to the next meeting of the Committee in relation to the operation and liabilities associated with "Rights of Way", and
- (3) that the report be otherwise noted.
