**1.0 Purpose**

The purpose of this report is to inform the Sub Committee of proposals to fund Playschemes operating during Easter 1999.

**2.0 Background**

2.1 At its meeting of 22 April 1998, the Policy and Resources (Community Development) Sub Committee considered the budget allocation for the Interim Community Grants Scheme and in doing so agreed to set aside £31,050 to fund playschemes operating in 1998/99.

2.2 In considering request for financial assistance to Playschemes during 1998/99, the Sub Committee agreed to adopt a formula which would ensure that the level of grant award would reflect the level of service provided.

2.3 The Sub Committee is reminded of the details of the formula:-

- Grant award is based on a point allocation system where points are allocated per session. One session being not more than 4 hours, with a maximum of 2 sessions per day being funded.
- A further allocation of points would be applied to reflect certain circumstances
- Playschemes catering for less than 50 children - 1 point per session
- Playschemes catering for 50 children or more - 2 points per session
- Playschemes catering for children under 8 years - 20 points
- Playschemes integrating children with special needs - 30 points
- Total points for all playschemes is then divided into budget allocation to give a pence per point figure. The grant award therefore equals total points and pence per points.

2.4 The Sub Committee further agreed to provide additional funding to support playschemes which solely provided places for children with special needs, with additional funding reflecting the additional costs incurred by this type of Playscheme.

2.5 Playschemes will operate during the weeks 26 March - 9 April 1999. At this stage the Chief Executive's Department is in receipt of 36 applications for the Easter 1999 period.

2.6 To date the Sub Committee has granted £25,631.52 leaving £5418.48 for Easter 1999. Recommendations for Easter 1999 are now contained in the schedule attached as Appendix 1 of this report.

### 3.0 Recommendation

3.1 It is recommended that the Sub Committee

- (i) approve grant awards to playschemes operating during Easter 1999 as detailed in Appendix 1; and
- (ii) otherwise note the contents of this report.
