1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 The purpose of this report is to transfer post of Council Officer from Planning and Environment's establishment to that of the Department of Social Work.

2. Background

- 2.1 In 1996 a post of Council Officer was transferred from the Department of Administration to Planning and Environment to cover the duties involved in opening and closing of Bron Way, together with Court duties.
- 2.2 Planning and Environment have now transferred all staff out of Bron Way offices and the Department of Social Work have taken over this accommodation.
- 2.3 Accordingly this post, together with funding of £23,034 should be transferred from Planning and Environment to the Department of Social Work.

3. Recommendations

Committee is asked to:

- (i) Approve the transfer of the post of Council Officer (NLC 5) from Planning and Environment to Social Work together with the relevant funding.
- (ii) refer the report to Social Work Committee
- (iii) refer the report to the Planning and Environment Committee and Policy and Resources (Personnel) Sub Committee.
