DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES - GRIEVANCE APPEAL

1. There was submitted intimation dated 30 May 2006 of a grievance appeal by Appellant 14/2006, together with a report dated 26 August 2006 by the Director of Community Services in explanation of the circumstances leading to the grievance.

The Sub-Committee then heard representations and submissions from the Appellant and representations and submissions from the Head of Land Services, as the representative of the Department of Community Services.

Thereafter, both parties withdrew from the meeting and the Sub-Committee resumed consideration of the matter.

Both parties were then re-admitted to the meeting.

Decided: that the grounds of the appeal had not been substantiated and that the appeal be not upheld.
