**1. Purpose of Report**

- 1.1. The purpose of the report is to seek consideration to the appointment of one elected member and one substitute member to the Clyde Valley Learning & Development Joint Committee.

**2. Background**

- 2.1. As members will be aware, the Council has been working with the Clyde Valley Councils on a collaborative approach to learning and development for employees. This project was the subject of a report to the Policy & Resources (Personnel) Sub-Committee on 14 March 2007.
- 2.2. The above report provided information to members of project progress to date, and outlined arrangements for project governance. This saw the establishment of a Joint Committee, made up of member representatives from the eight local authorities which make up the Clyde Valley Consortium. While the recommendations of the report were agreed on 14 March 2007, the committee deferred the decision of which members would represent North Lanarkshire Council on the Joint Committee until after the 2007 elections.
- 2.3 This issue is still outstanding, and North Lanarkshire Council has the opportunity to appoint one elected member and one substitute member to the Joint Committee.

**3. Recommendations**

- 3.1 Council is asked to give consideration to the appointment of one elected member and one substitute member to the Joint Committee of the Clyde Valley Learning & Development Consortium.
