NOTICE OF INTENT TO IMPOSE CONDITIONS - REGISTRATION FOR DRUMPARK COTTAGE, BARGEDDIE - HEARING

1. There were submitted (1) Procedures for Hearing regarding Intent to Impose Conditions; (2) report by the Principal Officer for Registration and Inspection to the Director of Social Work on the basis of which the Director of Social Work, in exercise of the powers delegated to him, took the decision to issue Notice of Intent to Impose Conditions in respect of Drumpark Cottage, 217 Langmuir Road, Bargeddie, and (3) submissions on behalf of the Director of Social Work and on behalf of the persons registered.

The Sub-Committee thereafter heard representations on behalf of the persons registered and on behalf of the Director of Social Work regarding procedural matters the content of the submissions by both parties and the date of receipt of these submissions, all of which had been lodged with the Clerk and sent to the other party within ten days of the date of the Hearing.

Following consideration of the representations, the Sub-Committee decided to adjourn the Hearing to a later date.
