**1. Purpose of Report/Introduction**

The purpose of this report is to declare the properties known as Meadowside House in Airdrie and Lochview House in Coatbridge surplus to the requirements of the Social Work Department.

**2. Background**

- 2.1. Meadowside House and Lochview House were previously used as care homes for the elderly.
- 2.2. The homes are now closed with all of the residents having been transferred to alternative care homes.

**3. Proposals/Considerations**


- 3.1. The two properties in Coatbridge and Airdrie are no longer required to offer the services formerly provided and are not required for the provision of other Social Work Services.
- 3.2. It is proposed to declare the properties surplus to requirement of the Social Work Department.
