1. Purpose of Report

To advise of correspondence received from Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Ramblers Association advising of a twinning visit to Bron, France during April 2008.

2. Background

The recommendations of the Working Party on Twinning approved by Council, extends to the provision of £50 for the first five days, or part thereof, plus £5 per day thereafter for visits to the Council's twin towns.

3. Considerations

- 3.1. Correspondence has been received from Cumbernauld and Kilsyth Ramblers Association advising that in partnership with Cumbernauld/Bron Association, eight members of the Ramblers Association travelled to Bron, France from 6-12 April 2008 and seeking financial assistance towards the visits.
- 3.2. The Association further advised that they have been liaising with the Culture Department in Bron who have drawn up a programme for the visit.
