Out of Hours NHS services cuts attracted a big crowd to our December meeting. Local folk made it very clear that they are not happy with the proposals. They wish to see, ideally, a service from the New Health Centre in Kilsyth, or retain Cumbernauld. A strong case was made for allowing local people to use the much more accessible services at Larbert and Stobhill .We hope the NHS reps will take this on board.

We have responded to two NLC planning reports, Kelvin Valley Action Plan 2, and LDP Call for sites. Our work with LEADER continues.
