1. **Purpose of Report**

To advise Members of a consultation by Post Office Limited on the relocation of the Cleland Branch of the Post Office.

2. **Background**

The Post Office are consulting on the proposals of the relocation of Cleland Post Office from 14 Main Street, Cleland, the distance of 60 yards to new premises at Scotmid Co-op, 29A Main Street, Cleland. The consultation closing date is 2 June 2009.

3. **Proposals**

The Post Office advise that they support the proposals. The main reasons for supporting this move is to safeguard Post Office services in the area and the view that the move would also enable the Post Office to enhance existing facilities at the new service:-

- a brand new, modern, purpose built serving counter
- flat level entrance, with a wide automatic door, for ease of access for customers with mobility constraints
- improved car parking facilities, with on-site parking available for customers immediately behind the store and a disabled parking bay within 10 yards of the main entrance.

4. **Recommendation**

Members are asked to note that the Post Office are consulting on their proposal to relocate Cleland Post Office a distance of 60 yards from its existing premises at 14 Main Street to new premises at Scotmid C-op, 29A Main Street, Cleland.
