Anne – Confirmed booking of circus skills and climbing wall, still to change the school booking. Anne to liase with Linda Hone

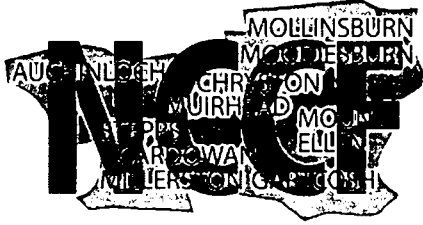
Marvyn – get quote for posters and leaflets and pass to Anne
