1. Auchinloch:

7. Paths and Rights of Way Project:

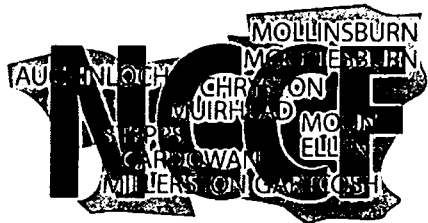
