1. Purpose of Report

The report submits, for consideration by the Committee, proposals for local public holidays in calendar year 2016 for factories and businesses in North Lanarkshire.

2. Background

- 2.1. The Council requires to determine annually the dates to be set for local public holidays for factories and businesses. The determination of staff holidays is a matter of separate consideration.
- 2.2. At its meeting held on 7 August 1996, the former General Purposes Committee agreed, in principle, that the North Lanarkshire local public holidays for factories and businesses should, generally, follow the pattern which had been adopted by the previous constituent authorities.
- 2.3. This Committee considers annually the dates to be set for local public holidays for factories and businesses. There is no need to alter that pattern.

3. Proposals

It is proposed that local public holidays for factories and businesses in 2016 be as follows:-

Friday, 1 January 2016
Monday, 4 January 2016
Monday, 28 March 2016
Monday, 2 May 2016
Monday, 30 May 2016
Monday, 18 July 2016
Monday, 26 September 2016
Monday, 26 December 2016
Tuesday, 27 December 2016

4. Recommendation

It is recommended that the Committee consider the foregoing public holidays for factories and businesses in North Lanarkshire for 2016.
