

**North Lanarkshire Council**

**Dunsiston Road, Airdrie**

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2015**

On 12 October 2015 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of water supply pipe works) on Dunsiston Road, Airdrie from its junction with Craigens Road, north eastwards to its junction with Roughrigg Road, Airdrie, a distance of 1,070 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Craigens Road and north westwards then northwards on Roughrigg Road to the north east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should travel vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 26 October 2015 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Sunday, 8 November 2015.

**(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2015**

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Dunsiston Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2015” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-sixth day of October, Two thousand and fifteen until 2359 hours on Sunday, the eighth day of November, Two thousand and fifteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the installation of water supply pipe works) on Dunsiston Road, Airdrie from its junction with Craigens Road, north eastwards to its junction with Roughrigg Road, Airdrie, a distance of 1,070 metres or thereby, by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

*Alternative routes: Vehicles on the south west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure should proceed south eastwards on Craigens Road and north westwards then northwards on Roughrigg Road to the north east side of the closure.*

*Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to travel to the south west side of the closure should travel vice versa.*

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
