Lenzie Road and Whitehill Farm Road, Stepps

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2014

On 6 January 2014 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the construction of a culvert overflow) on the undernoted roads by reason of works being executed on or near those locations.

Road Closures

Lenzie Road, Stepps from its junction with Mount Harriet Drive, southwards to a point 25 metres or thereby, south of the extended line of the southern kerb of Anniesdale Avenue.

Whitehill Farm Road, Stepps from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Whitehill Avenue, north eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Lenzie Road.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed northwards then north eastwards on Lenzie Road, south eastwards on B757 Stepps Road, south westwards and south eastwards on A806, south westwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road and northwards on Lenzie Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed southwards on Whitehill Avenue, north eastwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road and northwards on Lenzie Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed southwards on Whitehill Avenue, north eastwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road, north westwards and north eastwards on A806, north westwards on B757 Stepps Road and south westwards and southwards on Lenzie Road to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Anniesdale Avenue on the east side of the closure wishing to access the south side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Anniesdale Avenue, southwards on Blenheim Avenue, south westwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road and northwards on Lenzie Road to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access Anniesdale Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Anniesdale Avenue on the east side of the closure wishing to access the north east side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Anniesdale Avenue, northwards on Blenheim Avenue and south westwards on Mount Harriet Drive to the north east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure wishing to access Anniesdale Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on Anniesdale Avenue on the east side of the closure wishing to access the north west side of the closure should proceed north eastwards on Anniesdale Avenue, southwards on Blenheim Avenue, south westwards on A80 Cumbernauld Road and northwards on Whitehill Avenue to the north west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to access Anniesdale Avenue should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, by arrangement with the Contractor throughout the duration of the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 20 January 2014 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 18 April 2014.
