## 1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 This report is to update the Local Area Partnership on progress with the Local Development Programme for 2014/15 and 2015/16. The report also includes the recently approved programme for 2016/17

## 2. Background

- 3.1 To be eligible for inclusion in the Local Development Programme, projects must subscribe to previously agreed criteria. The following are examples of some of the criteria:
- Be linked to the work of the Local Area Teams
  - Be publicly visible and accessible
  - Come from community groups or individuals
  - Improve community safety
  - Benefit a large number of people
  - Improve the appearance of an area
  - Maximise the use of alternative sources of funding


## 5. Corporate Considerations
