

North Lanarkshire Council
Burnhead Road, Airdrie
(Temporary Closure) Order 2016

On 18 July 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge demolition works) on Burnhead Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of Airdrie Hill Street, south eastwards to the extended line of the northern kerb of Church Crescent, Airdrie by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south east side of the closure should proceed westwards on Burnhead Road, south eastwards on A73 Motherwell Street, north eastwards, eastwards then south eastwards on B8058 Braidenhill Road and northwards on Burnhead Road to the southeast side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to travel to the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 1 August 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Friday, 30 September 2016.

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Burnhead Road, Airdrie) (Temporary Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the first day of August, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Friday, the thirtieth day of September, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on bridge demolition works) on Burnhead Road, Airdrie from the extended line of the southern kerb of Airdriehill Street, south eastwards to the extended line of the northern kerb of Church Crescent, Airdrie by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

Alternative routes: Vehicles on the north west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south east side of the closure should proceed westwards on Burnhead Road, south eastwards on A73 Motherwell Street, north eastwards, eastwards then south eastwards on B8058 Braidenhill Road and northwards on Burnhead Road to the south east side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south east side of the closure wishing to travel to the north west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

Vehicular access will be maintained, where practicable, during the closure.
