Various Streets, Viewpark – Film Production

(Temporary Closure) Order 2016

On 13 June 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, made the above-named Order, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on film production works) to be observed by vehicles on the undernoted roads.

Road Closures

Blackthorn Road over its entire length.

McCracken Drive from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Sycamore Avenue, eastwards to the extended the extended line of the western kerb of Cedar Drive.

Redwood Crescent from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Citrus Crescent, eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Tamarack Crescent, a distance of 185 metres or thereby.

Tamarack Crescent from the extended line of the northern kerb of Redwood Crescent, north eastwards then northwards to the extended line of the southern kerb of Ivy Road, a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

Cedar Drive from the extended line of the northern kerb of McCracken Drive, northwards to the extended line of the southern kerb of Ivy Road.

Redwood Place over its entire length.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure on Cedar Drive wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed westwards on Ivy Road, northwards and westwards on Tamarack Crescent and westwards, southwards and eastwards on Redwood Crescent to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure on Cedar Drive should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure on Tamarack Crescent wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed northwards and westwards on Tamarack Crescent and westwards, southwards and eastwards on Redwood Crescent to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure on Tamarack Crescent should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure on Cedar Drive wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed westwards on Ivy Road, northwards and westwards on Tamarack Crescent, westwards and southwards on Redwood Crescent, westwards on Mulberry Road and southwards and eastwards on McCracken Drive to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure on Cedar Drive should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure on Tamarack Crescent wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed northwards and westwards on Tamarack Crescent, westwards on Mulberry Road and southwards and eastwards on McCracken Drive to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure on Tamarack Crescent should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the south side of the closure should proceed westwards and northwards on Redwood Crescent, westwards on Mulberry Road and southwards and eastwards on McCracken Drive to the south side of the closure.

Vehicles on the south side of the closure wishing to access the west side of the closure should proceed vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation at 0001 hours on Monday, 27 June 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Tuesday, 28 June 2016.

(Temporary Closure) Order 2016

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Streets, Viewpark – Film Production) (Temporary Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Monday, the twenty-seventh day of June, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Tuesday, the twenty-eighth day of June, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on film production works) to be observed by vehicles on the undernoted roads.

Road Closures

Blackthorn Road over its entire length.

McCracken Drive from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Sycamore Avenue, eastwards to the extended the extended line of the western kerb of Cedar Drive.

Redwood Crescent from the extended line of the eastern kerb of Citrus Crescent, eastwards to the extended line of the western kerb of Tamarack Crescent, a distance of 185 metres or thereby.

Tamarack Crescent from the extended line of the northern kerb of Redwood Crescent, north eastwards then northwards to the extended line of the southern kerb of Ivy Road, a distance of 70 metres or thereby.

Cedar Drive from the extended line of the northern kerb of McCracken Drive, northwards to the extended line of the southern kerb of Ivy Road.

Redwood Place over its entire length.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure on Cedar Drive wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed westwards on Ivy Road, northwards and westwards on Tamarack Crescent and westwards, southwards and eastwards on Redwood Crescent to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure on Cedar Drive should proceed vice versa.

Vehicles on the north east side of the closure on Tamarack Crescent wishing to travel to the west side of the closure should proceed northwards and westwards on Tamarack Crescent and westwards, southwards and eastwards on Redwood Crescent to the west side of the closure.

Vehicles on the west side of the closure wishing to travel to the north east side of the closure on Tamarack Crescent should proceed vice versa.
