(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

On 13 June 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway subsidence works) on Moffat View, Airdrie from the extended line of the south eastern kerb of Livingston Drive north eastwards to its termination by reason of works being executed on or near that location.

There are no alternative routes.

The Order, which will be effective only when signage is in place, will come into operation at 0001 hours on Friday, 1 July 2016 and will remain in operation until 2359 hours on Saturday, 31 December 2016.

(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Moffat View, Airdrie) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2016” and shall be effective during the period from 0001 hours on Friday, the First day of July, Two thousand and sixteen until 2359 hours on Saturday, the Thirty First day of December, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on carriageway subsidence works) on Moffat View, Airdrie from the extended line of the south eastern kerb of Livingston Drive north eastwards to its termination by reason of works being executed on or near that location.
