1. Purpose of Report

- 1.1 This report is to update the Local Area Partnership on progress with the Local Development Programme for 2014/15 and 2015/16. The report also updates projects approved within the 2016/17 programme.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Partnership will recall at the Local Area Partnership meeting held in January 2015 that a list of projects was approved for progression over the financial year 2015/16. There are also the remaining projects from 2014/15 to be completed. The partnership also approved in January 2016 the programme for 2016/17.

3. Criteria for Local Development Programme

- 3.1 To be eligible for inclusion in the Local Development Programme, projects must subscribe to previously agreed criteria. The following are examples of some of the criteria:
- Be linked to the work of the Local Area Teams
 - Be publicly visible and accessible
 - Come from community groups or individuals
 - Improve community safety
 - Benefit a large number of people
 - Improve the appearance of an area
 - Maximise the use of alternative sources of funding

- 4.1 Progress with the 2014/15 programme is shown at **Appendix 1**. Progress with the 2015/16 programme is shown at **Appendix 2**. Approved projects for the 2016/17 programme are shown at **Appendix 3**.
