Various Streets, Motherwell (Strathclyde Country Park Fireworks Display)

(Temporary No Waiting or Loading Restrictions) Order 2016

On 17 October 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, made the above-named Order to be observed by vehicles between 1201 hours and 2359 hours on Saturday, 5 November 2016, the Order being notified on the roads by the use of Police "No Waiting" cones.

No Waiting or Loading

To apply to both sides of the following roads:-

- (1) Hamilton Road, Motherwell from the South Lanarkshire boundary on the Clyde Bridge, north eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Tinkers Lane;
- (2) Airbles Road, Motherwell from its junction with Hamilton Road eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Tinkers Lane;
- (3) Tinkers Lane, Motherwell over its entire length;
- (4) Greenacres, Motherwell from its junction with Airbles Road southwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby;
- (5) Braedale Avenue, Motherwell over its entire length
- (6) Haughview Road, Motherwell over its entire length, including the kerblines abutting the central reservation.

To apply to the eastern kerblines:-

- (7) Strathclyde Road, Motherwell over its entire length.

Contravention of the Order, which may be inspected at the Civic Centre, Windmillhill Street, Motherwell could result in a penalty of up to £500.

(Temporary No Waiting or Loading Restrictions) Order 2016

On 17 October 2016, the North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

No Waiting or Loading

To apply to both sides of the following roads:-

- (1) Hamilton Road, Motherwell from the South Lanarkshire boundary on the Clyde Bridge, north eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Tinkers Lane;
- (2) Airbles Road, Motherwell from its junction with Hamilton Road eastwards to the extended line of the eastern kerb of Tinkers Lane;
- (3) Tinkers Lane, Motherwell over its entire length;
- (4) Greenacres, Motherwell from its junction with Airbles Road southwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby;
- (5) Braedale Avenue, Motherwell over its entire length
- (6) Haughview Road, Motherwell over its entire length, including the kerblines abutting the central reservation.

To apply to the eastern kerblines:-

- (7) Strathclyde Road, Motherwell over its entire length.

Contravention of the Order, which may be inspected at the Civic Centre, Windmillhill Street, Motherwell could result in a penalty of up to £500.

The Order will operate between the hours of 1201 hours and 2359 hours on Saturday, the fifth day of November, Two thousand and sixteen.
