Various Roads, Cumbernauld

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2016

On 2 November 2016 the North Lanarkshire Council made the above-named Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and in exercise of all other enabling powers, which makes it unlawful for any person to (1) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Royal British Legion Remembrance Day Parade) on the undernoted roads, and (2) drive at more than 30 mph on the undernoted roads.

Road Closures

Slip Road 1

The On-Slip Road from the extended line of the southern kerb of B8054 Lye Brae, Cumbernauld north eastwards to the northbound carriageway of the A8011.

Alternative Route: Vehicles on B8054 Lye Brae wishing to travel to the northbound carriageway of the A8011 should proceed westwards on Slip Road 8, south westwards on A8011 Central Way, proceed around Town Centre Roundabout and exit and proceed north eastwards on A8011 Central Way.

Slip Road 2

The On-Slip Road from its junction with Braehead Roundabout, Cumbernauld northwards to the northbound carriageway of the A8011.

Alternative Route: Vehicles travelling from Seafar Road/Kildrum Road/North Carbrain Road wishing to travel to the northbound carriageway of the A8011 Wilderness Brae should proceed around Braehead Roundabout, exit and proceed south westwards on A8011 Central Way, proceed around Town Centre Roundabout and exit and proceed north eastwards on A8011 Central Way.

Slip Road 3

The Off-Slip Road from its junction with the northbound carriageway of the A8011 north eastwards to its junction with B8054 Lye Brae.

Alternative Route: Vehicles travelling northwards on the A8011 Central Way wishing to travel to Braehead Roundabout should continue northwards on A8011 Central Way and A8011 Wilderness Brae, proceed around Old Inns Roundabout, exit and proceed southwards on A8011 Wilderness Brae and Off-Slip Road 5 to Braehead Roundabout.

Slip Road 4

The Off-Slip Road from its junction with the southbound carriageway of the A8011, north westwards, south westwards and south eastwards to the main south eastbound carriageway of B8054 Lye Brae.

Alternative Route: Vehicles travelling northwards on A8011 Central Way wishing to travel to B8054 Lye Brae should continue northwards on A8011 Central Way and A8011 Wilderness

Brae, proceed around Old Inns Roundabout and exit and proceed southwards on A8011 Wilderness Brae and Off-Slip Road 7 to B8054 Lye Brae.

30 MPH Speed Restriction

As part of the proposals a 30 MPH Speed Restriction will also be in place on A8011 Central Way from its junction with Town Centre East roundabout, northwards on A8011 Central Way and A8011 Wilderness Brae for a distance of 1.9 km or thereby.

The Order, which will only be operational when displayed by signs, will come into operation at 1000 hours on Sunday, 13 November 2016 and will remain in operation until 1200 hours on Sunday, 13 November 2016.

(Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2016

The North Lanarkshire Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The North Lanarkshire Council (Various Roads, Cumbernauld) (Temporary Traffic Management) Order 2016” and shall only be operational when signing is in place will be effective during the period from 1000 hours on Sunday, the thirteenth day of November, Two thousand and sixteen and will remain in operation until 1200 hours on Sunday, the thirteenth day of November, Two thousand and sixteen.
2. No person to drive or cause to be driven or permit any motor vehicle to (1) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle (with the exception of vehicles engaged on the Royal British Legion Remembrance Day Parade) on the undernoted roads, and (2) drive at more than 30 mph on the undernoted roads.

Road Closures

Slip Road 1

The On-Slip Road from the extended line of the southern kerb of B8054 Lye Brae, Cumbernauld north eastwards to the northbound carriageway of the A8011.

Alternative Route: Vehicles on B8054 Lye Brae wishing to travel to the northbound carriageway of the A8011 should proceed westwards on Slip Road 8, south westwards on A8011 Central Way, proceed around Town Centre Roundabout and exit and proceed north eastwards on A8011 Central Way.

Slip Road 2

The On-Slip Road from its junction with Braehead Roundabout, Cumbernauld northwards to the northbound carriageway of the A8011.

Alternative Route: Vehicles travelling from Seafar Road/Kildrum Road/North Carbrain Road wishing to travel to the northbound carriageway of the A8011 Wilderness Brae should proceed around Braehead Roundabout, exit and proceed south westwards on A8011 Central Way, proceed around Town Centre Roundabout and exit and proceed north eastwards on A8011 Central Way.

Slip Road 3

The Off-Slip Road from its junction with the northbound carriageway of the A8011 north eastwards to its junction with B8054 Lye Brae.

Alternative Route: Vehicles travelling northwards on the A8011 Central Way wishing to travel to Braehead Roundabout should continue northwards on A8011 Central Way and A8011 Wilderness Brae, proceed around Old Inns Roundabout, exit and proceed southwards on A8011 Wilderness Brae and Off-Slip Road 5 to Braehead Roundabout.

Slip Road 4

The Off-Slip Road from its junction with the southbound carriageway of the A8011, north westwards, south westwards and south eastwards to the main south eastbound carriageway of B8054 Lye Brae.

Alternative Route: Vehicles travelling northwards on A8011 Central Way wishing to travel to B8054 Lye Brae should continue northwards on A8011 Central Way and A8011 Wilderness Brae, proceed around Old Inns Roundabout and exit and proceed southwards on A8011 Wilderness Brae and Off-Slip Road 7 to B8054 Lye Brae.

30 MPH Speed Restriction

As part of the proposals a 30 MPH Speed Restriction will also be in place on A8011 Central Way from its junction with Town Centre East roundabout, northwards on A8011 Central Way and A8011 Wilderness Brae for a distance of 1.9 km or thereby.
